Approval of Minutes

- The minutes for October were approved as read.
- Minutes were translated for Spanish speaking parents

Principal Update

- HB4545 and tutoring
 - Students in 4th and 5th grade that did not pass the STAAR are required to have an extra 30 hours in small groups during or after school by the state of Texas.
 - Groups should be no bigger than 3 but we can get permission to have larger groups if parents sign giving permission for their child to participate in a larger group.

- Beginning in January, we will begin to offer tutoring sessions for 4th, 5th, and possibly 3rd grade students.

Superintendent Roundtable Update:

- Possible changes to the calendar
 - Next year we have 8 extra days to use as needed due to no longer being penalized for the online learning and the late start we had the previous year due to COVID
 - Possible early release days: all schools would be released 1 hour early allowing teachers extra time to work.
 - Parent conferences would take place on 2 days after school for 3 hours each day instead of a designated federal holiday as we do now. Teachers would be allowed to leave 3 hours early on a designated day to make-up for those extra hours worked after school. Another option would be we get those hours back by being given a day off on a day where subs are in high demand such as ACL.
- MEAC Update
 - Looking for a person to replace Dr. Kauffman who has left the district; the position has been elevated to Associate Superintendent
 - Trying to implement the dual language program in more schools
- DAC Update
 - Will be discussed at the next meeting

Other CAC Business

- PTA Update
 - We bought pies for the teachers
 - We continue collecting memberships
- Parent Engagement Events
 - We continue to have English classes. An invitation will be extended to invite more parents in January. Mrs. Galindo provides child care while parents are in class
